- The name of the event or the performer
- The location of the event
- The date and time of the event
- A brief description of the event
- Ticket price, if applicable
- Contact information that can be published. We prefer a phone number and web address or email.
- Photos if you have them

Our deadlines usually run approximately a month prior to publication date. They can be found at www.artsmagazine.info under the advertising tab.
